Sub: Release of 1st Installment of NSS Grant for Regular activities and special camping activities under National Service Scheme (NSS) to Government of Jammu & Kashmir.

Sanction is hereby accorded to the release of NSS Grant amounting to **Rs. 69,93,750/-** (Rupees Sixty Nine Lakhs Ninety Three Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty only) as first installment (25%) (Annexure attached) of central assistance for the year 2023-24 as per the revised rates to the Govt. of Jammu and Kashmir for Regular Activities and Special Camping Programmes of NSS.

Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide its OM No 40(05)PFC-II/2017-D dated 03.01.2023 and O.M No 01(01)/PFC-I/2022 dated 01.02.2022 has approved the revised rates of Regular Activities and Special Camping for next 5 years I.e 2021-22 to 2025-26 under National Service Scheme (NSS) a Central Sector Scheme. Accordingly, the expenditure under NSS will now be fully funded by this Department. NSS Grants are sanctioned @ Rs 400 per volunteers per year for Regular Camping activities and @ 700 per volunteers per year (for 50% of NSS Strength) for Special Camping Activities.

The Registrars/ Programme Coordinators/ Programme officers/ DDO concerned shall

1. Certify that all the grants sanctioned by the central Government upto 31.03.2023 have been utilized.
2. Number of NSS volunteers should have been actually enrolled for the year 2023-24.
3. Utilization certificate of NSS Grants for the year 2023-24 in the form of GFR 12-C would be submitted by the concerned Universities/DDO in the 1st Quarter of next financial year.



4. Utilization of the amount for the purpose these are sanctioned.
5. Utilization of the amount after fulfilling all other codal formalities and guidelines of the scheme.
6. Review the performance of concerned NSS unit periodically and shall furnish physical and financial progress of Regular NSS Activities and Special Camping programme monthly.
7. Immediately, after the release of grants a disbursement certificate is to be furnished to the effect that the entire amount released vide this letter has been disbursed to the colleges/institutions/ +2 councils. The certificate should also indicate year wise unspent balance, if any, out of the previous year grants available with the Universities, Colleges, Institutions/+2 councils and which are to be taken into account in respect of all the Central grants.

The amount of **Rs. 69,93,750/-** (Rupees Sixty Nine Lakhs Ninety Three Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty only) shall be drawn by the Drawing and Disbursing Officer (Grant-in-Aid) Directorate of Colleges, Higher Education Department (State Nodal Officer, J&K) electronically transferred to the PFMS Portal. The funds received from the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports as NSS Grants will be released through Central Nodal agency (CNA) under Model-2 and the fund (not more than 25% at a time) may be released upon Utilization certificate or Expenditure statement of at least 75% of the funds released earlier and in compliance with the conditions of the previous sanction.
